9. Discuss with others "face to face" how you can collectively support and encourage one another in times of doubt or uncertainty, similar to Abraham and his interactions with God.
10. Are there areas where you struggle to trust in His faithfulness? What would surrendering those doubts to Him look like?
11. Reflect on the implications of God's covenant with Abraham for your own identity as a believer. How does being part of God's covenant community shape your perspective on life and relationships?
